

# Dallas Industries

Dallas' historically important industries remain its largest employers. Being a city founded on services (insurance and banking) and trade ensured that professional services, finance and trade still dominates the economy.

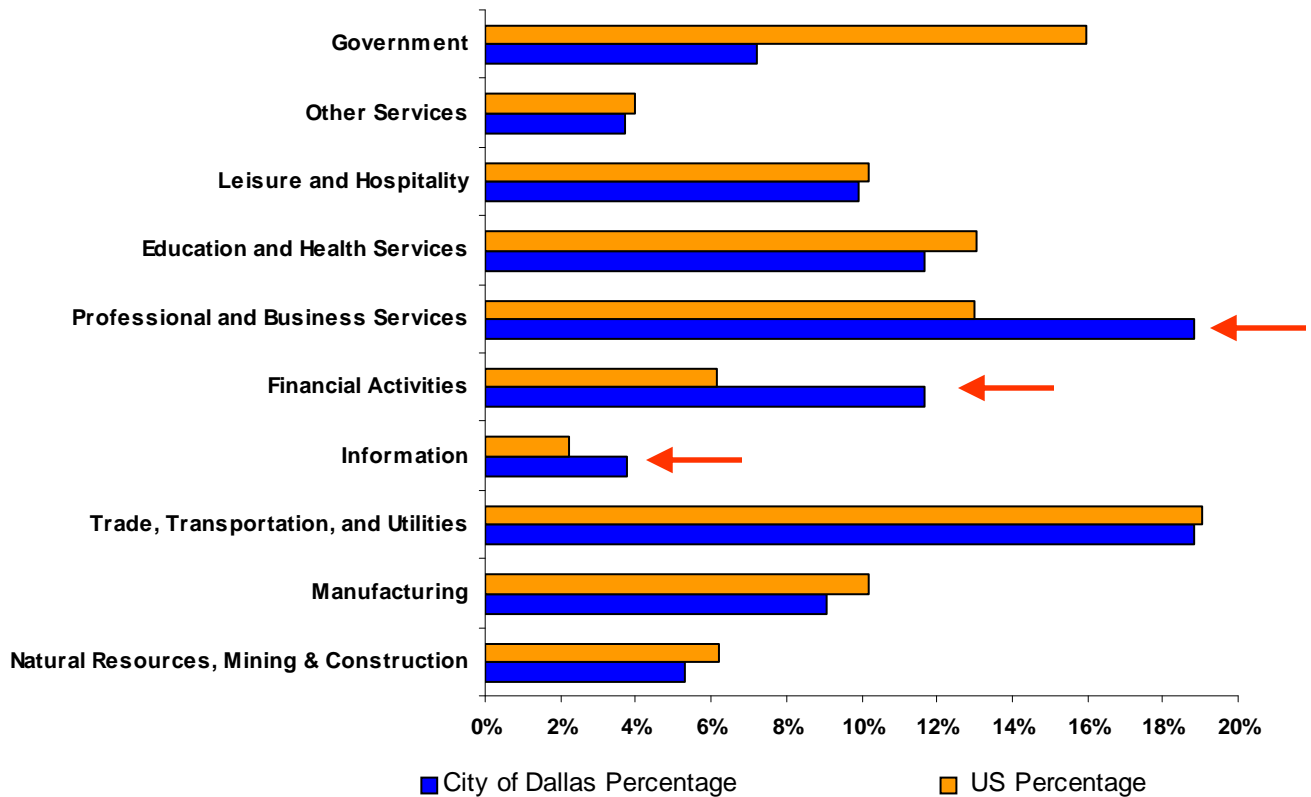
Dallas' concentration of high-end services exceed the national average in professional services, finance and information jobs. Dallas exceeds the rest of DFW in these three as well as health care and education.

Thriving professional services and exemplary transportation assets also made Dallas a head-quarters magnet. 21 Fortune 1000 firms call Dallas home (including 11 of DFW's 24 Fortune 500). Another 100 headquarters that each employ at least 1,000 globally are based in the city limits.
